



2011 Sea Base Live-A-Board

Florida Sea Base, Islamorada, FL

July 5 to July 12, 2011

(Registration due no later than September 28, 2010)

Are you ready for the ultimate Scout experience? Are you ready to challenge yourself physically, mentally, and emotionally? Are you ready for an unforgettable outdoor, underwater experience in the Florida Keys? Are you going to be 14 years old Sept. 1, 2011? Then you are ready for the 2011 Sea Base Live-A-Board Adventure.

The Florida Sea Base has combined the sailing and scuba diving programs for one incredible adventure. On this adventure you will be spending your days not only scuba diving, but sailing around the Florida Keys. With a crew size of 10 to 12 people, your home that will transport you from reef to reef is a 57-foot schooner.

During this adventure (weather permitting) you will get to dive 15 times, including 3 night dives. When you are not diving there are plenty of opportunities for sailing and fishing while cruising through the Florida Keys. All food, lodging and equipment are included, excluding personal fins, snorkel, diving flashlight and diving mask. These items must be furnished by each participant and / or rented on site at your cost. **You must be a certified diver to participate in this adventure. This is an eight-day event. Explicit health concerns require a special medical acceptance in this program.**

The approximate budget for this adventure is \$1,100 plus air fare. A \$100 deposit is due immediately to reserve your slot. The balance will be split into two \$500 payments due September 28, 2010 and March 1, 2011. This cost includes Sea Base trek cost and ground transportation from Miami International Airport to the Sea Base facility. Air transportation cost and scheduling for each participant is their own responsibility.

Please note, as with all BSA High Adventure Treks, participants will be physically and mentally challenged. Scouts and Scouters are to take the necessary pre-trek steps to assure their personal fitness level. It is critical to the overall success of the Team that all members can handle these challenges. **All participants will be required to provide a completed Sea Base Medical Form and comply with the physical fitness guidelines therein. Note attached sample.**
